## P/34/16 Planning Applications

### SDNP/16/04211/HOUS

Trevornick, 65 Sheepdown Drive, Petworth, GU28 0BX

Single story rear extension with flat roof and tiled edge.

Cllrs raised concerns about the application on the following grounds:

 Detrimental impact of the landscape and staggered architecture to the rear of properties on Sheepdown Drive and the consequential detrimental impact of views of and over the Shimmings Valley, an area of outstanding natural beauty.

2. The bulk of the extension and materials proposed for the construction were not in keeping

with adjacent buildings.

3. The privacy of both the garden and conservatory of the adjacent property at 63 Sheepdown Drive would be adversely affected.

4. The proposed casement window in the extension should either be deleted from the plan or be of a type which was fixed and unable to be opened with obscure glass fitted.

Ground Floor Swan House, Market Square, Petworth GU28 0AH

Minor ground floor internal alterations, including to existing toilet block to accommodate occupation. To install refrigeration and air conditioning plant and an external floor surfacing compliant access.

Cllrs raised concern about the design and access statement. Access proposals need to made clear and the proposed path of inputting of goods and materials stated clearly. There was particular concern regarding entrance D22 on the plan. Information about the use of this entrance was not provided. The application was considered incomplete and therefore an objection was raised on this basis.
