5 a. Bus Shelter at Station Road

Grant application sent to CDC with copies of estimates for both groundworks and shelter structure together with erection costs. Shona Turner at CDC suggested that all available S106 monies be claimed, this was agreed to be a sensible course of action and that the full sum would be applied for. b. <u>Skatepark</u>
